CLUBS & ACTIVITIES FOR THE SPRING TERM 2024

If your child wishes to attend Clubs and Activities for the Spring Term 2024, you will need to click on the link, which will be emailed to you. The online booking form will give you the option to book the clubs, which are listed here.

Please note that by using our online Booking Form you are notifying us of the clubs you wish your child to attend. All clubs have a minimum and maximum number of spaces. Spaces will be limited so please register your child as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis and once the maximum number has been reached a waiting list will be created. Children attending clubs that commence at or after 15:45 will be supervised until the activity starts. The club costs are detailed below. This cost is charged to the following term's school fees i.e. you are billed in arrears.

Please note that once your child starts a club you will be charged for the whole term.

If your child wishes to attend Football, Musical Theatre, Tennis, Creative Adventures, Chess, Martial Arts, Multi-Sports, or Street & Modern Dance, your details will be given to the club provider to enable them to organise classes. For Musical Theatre, Creative Adventures, Chess and Street & Modern Dance you will receive an invoice from the Club provider, all other clubs will be billed directly by the School.

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

Confirmation that your child has been allocated a place in their requested club(s) for the Spring Term will be sent to you via email as soon as possible. Clubs & Activities will run from **Monday 15th January** up to and including **Friday 22nd March** (9 weeks). The Spring Half Term break is one week commencing **Monday 12th February**.

DESCRIPTION OF CLUBS

Art	Art Club is aimed at inspiring children to be creative. The children will use a variety of media including painting, sketching, and clay modelling.
Chess	For players of all abilities, chess teaches children many fundamentals like problem solving, focus and patience. Chess Club ranges from an introduction to the game to advanced strategies – a fun activity to share with friends.
Choir	This is an opportunity for children who enjoy music to explore different styles and songs. Following some fun warm up games there is the opportunity to enjoy learning new melodies which are then performed at the Carol Service, Claygate Christmas Lights, Prize Day and other key events in the school calendar.
Cookery & Food Preparation	Cookery Club is an excellent way to learn basic life skills while exploring your child’s culinary creativity. The club is great fun and helps educate your child on food and food hygiene. It teaches them how to cook many delicious things, which you may have the opportunity to sample.
Creative Adventures	A mix of teacher-led drama and dance, story-telling, movement, dance steps, characterisation, understanding emotions, social interaction sensory play and imaginative play.
Football	Football Club gives your child the opportunity to develop their footballing skills, and learn to play as part of a team whilst having fun.
Instrumental lessons	Individual piano lessons can be taken in school. The benefits of learning an instrument include improved co-ordination, memory and listening skills. Your child will have the opportunity to play in concerts, enhancing confidence and presentation skills. Lessons will take place on the same day each week with a rotating timetable to minimise the impact on classroom learning or break time. Please do not sign up again if your child is already taking lessons. Please note that half a term’s notice is required should you wish to cancel your child’s music lessons.
Lego	Our Lego Club gives a chance for children to get creative with Lego bricks. Each week there will be a theme, with design challenges and competitions, either working individually or in teams. Happy building!

Multi-Sports	Multi-Sports Club will engage your child in a range of games over the term – from “Invasion” to more traditional sports, all developing sporting skills to improve movement and co-ordination.
Musical Theatre Club	LAMDA-based curriculum learning music and movement from The Lion King, Annie, Oliver, Matilda, Disney and more. Examinations take place at the end of the 2nd term but these are not compulsory.
Street & Modern Dance	For the younger children this will be fun, simple movement and teacher-led dance steps to favourite pop tunes to help with coordination, rhythm, confidence, timing, motor skills, listening skills and more. The older group will enjoy a mixture of popular tunes and R & B beats and mashups, learning choreographed dance moves, street moves and routines to showcase at the end of the term.
Tennis	Tennis Club takes advantage of the coaching expertise and the excellent facilities of Esher Tennis Club. Your child will be taken to train on their top-class courts and will learn new skills, enhance co-ordination and have fun. Suitable for beginners through to more experienced players.
